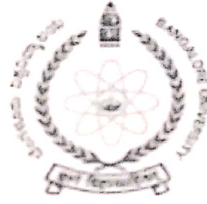

**ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION TO P.G. DIPLOMA  
& CERTIFICATE COURSES FOR THE ACADEMIC  
YEAR 2024-25**

(1) P.G. Diploma courses:

1. Regular course :

(A) Yoga Studies

2. Courses through ON-LINE

(A) Ambedkar Studies

(B) Rural Management

(C) Swami Vivekananda Studies

(D) Buddhist Studies

Eligibility Criteria:

(1) P.G. Diploma in Ambedkar Studies:

**Course Offered at:** Dr. B. R. Ambedkar Study and Research Centre, Bangalore University,  
Jnanabharathi Campus, Bangalore-56 (**Intake: 20**)

**Eligibility:** Graduate of any recognized University or any equivalent course with a minimum of 50% (in aggregate) shall be eligible (45% for SC/ST/category-I candidates)

(2) P.G. Diploma in Rural Development Studies:

**Course Offered at:** Centre for Rural Development Studies, Bangalore University,  
Jnanabharathi Campus, Bangalore-56 (**Intake: 20**)

**Eligibility:** Candidates who have completed three years Bachelors Degree and have secured 50% of Marks in the aggregate of all papers studied at the qualifying Examinations are eligible for admission into the course. In case of SC/ST/Cat-I students, the minimum percentage of marks required shall be in aggregate less by 5%.

(3) P.G. Diploma in Yoga Studies:

**Course Offered at:** (1) Centre for Yoga Studies, Dept of Performing Arts building, Bangalore University, Jnanabharathi Campus, Bangalore-56. (**Intake: 30**)

**Eligibility:** a) A candidate who has a degree in any faculty of Bangalore University or of any recognized University in India or abroad shall be eligible for admission to the P.G Diploma in Yoga Studies A candidate should be medically fit and of good character. Medical Fitness Certificate from the Bangalore University Health Centre or any Government medical officer must be produced at the time of admission. Student who are studying in a P.G course or any other course are also eligible for admission to the course.

b) **This is an Add on course extending over TWO Semesters.**

c) A Student shall be considered to have completed the course if he/she has attended not less than 80% of the class during the course.

**(4) P.G. Diploma in Swami Vivekananda Studies:**

**Course Offered at: Department of Philosophy, Bangalore University, Jnanabharathi Campus,  
Bangalore-56 ( Intake: 20)**

**Eligibility:** Graduate of any recognized University or any equivalent course with a minimum of 50% (in aggregate) shall be eligible to apply for the course, in case of SC/ST/CAT-1 students, the minimum percentage of marks required shall be in aggregate less by 5%

**(5) P.G. Diploma in Buddhist Studies :**

**Course Offered at: Department of Philosophy, Bangalore University, Jnanabharathi Campus,  
Bangalore-56. (Intake:20)**

**Eligibility :** Graduate of any recognized University or any equivalent course with a minimum of 50% (in aggregate) shall be eligible to apply for the course in case of SC/ST/CAT-1 students, the minimum percentage of marks required shall be in aggregate less by 5%.

**(1) Certificate Course in Dalit Movement :**

**Course Offered at:**

**1. Dr. B. R. Ambedkar Study and Research Centre, Bangalore University, Jnanabharathi  
Campus, Bangalore-56. (Intake: 20)**

**Eligibility:** Candidates should have passed PUC Examination.

**(2) Certificate Course in Yoga Studies :**

**Course Offered at:**

**1. Centre for Yoga Studies, Dept of Performing Arts building, Bangalore University,  
Jnanabharathi Campus, Bangalore-56. (Intake-20)**

**Regulations:**

- This is regular full-time course of 6 month duration with 20 hours of Instruction ( Theory+ Practice) per week.
- Any person who has attained 18 years of age and has a minimum qualification of PUC is eligible to seek admission.
- The minimum attendance requirement for completion of the course is 75% of the total number of classes.
- There will be two theory papers, one practical paper and a project report to be prepared by the students.
